MINI Grant - Guidelines

Why?

- Grants are to provide funding for those implementing the mission of Keep Going 25 in their communities
- Our mission is to give youth an opportunity to show up for others facing adversity to make their community and world a better place through love and service

What?

Grants are intended to support service-based learning projects where youth lead the way to love and serve within their community

- Projects must be action-oriented, impact the community, and focus on applicant's passion for helping others KEEP GOING
- One-time grants up to \$250; one grant per year per applicant

Who is eligible?

Individuals or group of students and young adults ages 10-25 who:

- Design a service-based learning project that benefits the community
- Demonstrate a personal passion for the community served by the project
- Develop and implement a plan for the use of the funds that furthers the mission to KEEP GOING
- Create a budget for the funds
- · Provide documented evidence of use of funds
- Submit grant application
- Give written and photographic feedback on grant impact

Examples of individuals or groups that are <u>not</u> eligible include:

- Sports teams to fund athletic events
- Political causes
- Association memberships
- Building or capital campaigns
